During the 2024 Young Canadian Simmental Association's (YCSA) National show, which was held the final day of the Olds portion of the WSFF Congress, the FCSF Directors presented \$15,000 from the auction proceeds to the YCSA for ongoing youth activities. The FCSF also continued their generous support for travel, and will continue their support of the FCSF and Trevor Vance Memorial Scholarships. Last year's winners were Carmen Wolfe, Jackson Goudy, Jordynn Rogers, Ruby Briand and Danica Davis. The FCSF also supports a bursary, won by Charles White and Olivia Woytuik for 2023. 2024 winners will be announced after the fall 2024 AGM.

"We are thrilled with the success of the record setting 2024 auction! It was exciting to see the full house of breeders from around the world and across Canada that gathered to celebrate the youth in the Simmental breed and beef industry and support the foundation and its causes. The funds raised will continue to be used for youth development, education, research, scholarships and bursaries."
